OPENING HYMN - COME AS YOU ARE

WORDS FROM SACRED SCRIPTURE

FIRST READING Read by Oscar Matthews

A reading from the letter of Saint Paul to the Romans (14:7-12)

Christ: Lord of living and dead.

The life and death of each of us has its influence on others; if we live, we live for the Lord; and if we die, we die for the Lord, so that alive or dead we belong to the Lord. This explains why Christ both died and came to life: it was so that he might be Lord both of the dead and of the living.
