And forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.

The Farewell & Committal

Please stand. Neil's coffin is sprinkled with Holy Water, then Fr. Scott leads us. The response to these prayers is: **Amen.**

After these prayers, the coffin is lowered while we listen to "Tears in Heaven" performed by Eric Clapton, after which, Fr. Scott Prays:

Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord, for they rest from their labours. **Amen.**

Concluding Prayer

Fr. Scott prays the concluding prayer. The response:

We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
